



Standard Operating Procedures

Signature 8 oz. Burritos Preparation

Burritos are cook-and-serve products and should be cooked to an internal temperature that reaches or exceeds 165°F. Equipment performance may vary. Adjust time and temperature accordingly.

COMMERCIAL MICROWAVE

Burritos: Chicken Fajita – Cook one

Thawed: Microwave 1100W for 1 Minute, 35 Seconds

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

Microwaves may vary. Adjust cooking times if necessary.

- Do not vent package.
- Place Burrito on edge of carousel.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

Burritos: Egg, Bacon, Cheese and Salsa /

Egg, Sausage, Cheese & Potato – Cook one

Thawed: Microwave 1100W for 1 Minute, 30 Seconds

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

Microwaves may vary. Adjust cooking times if necessary.

- Do not vent package.
- Place Burrito on edge of carousel.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

Burritos: Steak & Cheese – Cook one

Thawed: Microwave 1100W for 1 Minute, 15 Seconds

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

Microwaves may vary. Adjust cooking times if necessary.

- Do not vent package.
- Place Burrito on edge of carousel.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

CAUTION: PRODUCT MAY BE HOT

CONVECTION OVEN

Burritos: Chicken Fajita /

Egg, Bacon, Cheese and Salsa – Cook 4

Thawed: 350° for 34 Minutes

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

- Remove wrappers.
- Place 4 burritos on a parchment lined sheet pan.
- Tightly cover sheet with foil.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

Burritos: Egg, Sausage, Cheese & Potato – Cook 4

Thawed: 350° for 33 Minutes

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

- Remove wrappers.
- Place 4 burritos on a parchment lined sheet pan.
- Tightly cover sheet with foil.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

Burritos: Steak & Cheese – Cook 4

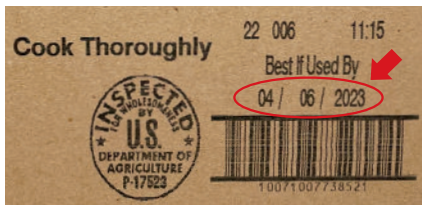
Thawed: 350° for 32 Minutes

Let stand for 1 minute before eating.

- Remove wrappers.
- Place 4 burritos on a parchment lined sheet pan.
- Tightly cover sheet with foil.
- Temperature of burrito filling must reach 165°F or above.

CAUTION: PRODUCT MAY BE HOT

Storage & Thawing:



- Product may be stored frozen for up to 455 days from the production date. The expiration date is printed above the barcode on the case.
- Thaw for 12-24 hours at a refrigerated temperature of 40°F or less. Thawing times may vary.

Quality Check After Cooking:

- Before serving, use a sanitized pocket thermometer to ensure that core temperature has exceeded 165°F.
- Hold for up to **3 hours** as long as core temperature remains above 140°F. Discard if below 140°F.
- Discard burritos that are excessively cracked or dried out.
